
Silent-Yachts has announced that the first 36-metre Silent 120 yacht is in-build at their shipyard in Turkey. The impressive flagship solar catamaran is able to create enough energy to not only power the yacht but all of her appliances.



The first unit of the Silent 120 catamaran began construction three weeks ago and is described by Silent-Yachts founder Michael Köhler as a "unique trend for the future of green yachting." The green yacht is able to use its solar panels to generate between 30-40 kWp of solar energy.



The aluminium Silent 120 yacht has a huge interior volume but remains under the 500 GT mark. She has been designed in full by Marco Casali Too Design who was responsible for her interior and exterior design as well as her naval architecture.



Silent 120 has custom design at the heart of her, with the first hull featuring a swimming pool on the aft deck and grassy areas for walking dogs on her side decks. Her solar hardtop is also designed to slide out in two sections reveal a touch-and-go helipad. When not in use, the upper sun deck can be used for sunbathing.



The Silent 120 explorer yacht is equipped solar panels on her roof, with the addition of back-up generators for fast running. As a result of this, she is able to cruise at a comfortable eight knots and can reach a top speed of 16 knots.



The Silent 120 yacht has an expected delivery date of early 2024.



Silent Yachts has also reported success in other areas of the shipyard with 11 other catamarans over 24-metres in-build; seven Silent 80 yachts and four Silent 82 yachts, in Turkey.
