

# Silent-Yachts transforms into Silent-Group

[Silent-Yachts](#) has morphed into the Silent-Group and now comprises of several distinct divisions. This restructuring has brought on six sub-divisions: Silent-Tenders, Silent-Management, Silent-Charter, Silent-Brokerage, Silent-Resort, Silent-Shop.

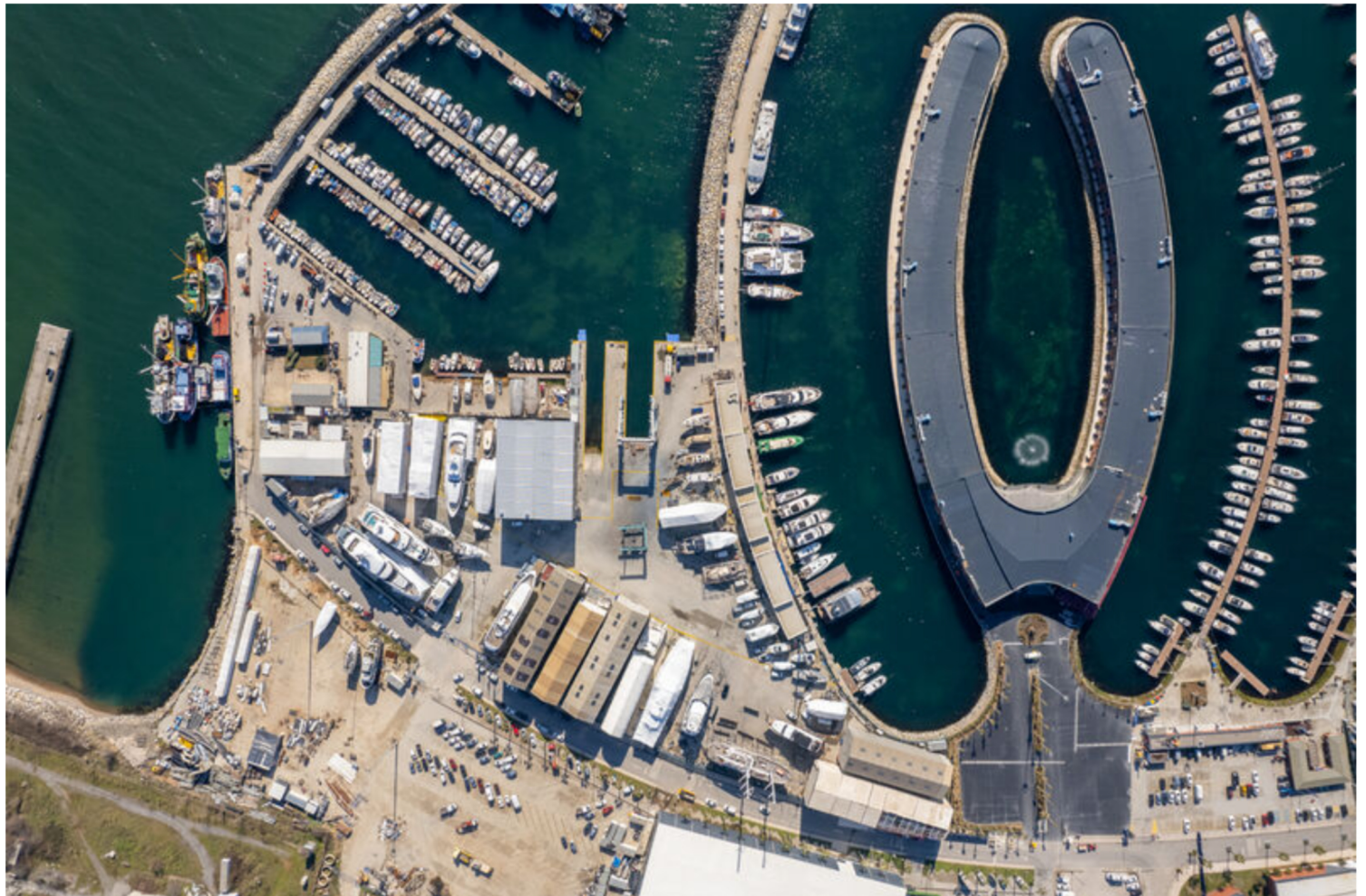
In addition to this restructuring, the shipbuilder will offer its first hybrid yacht, which will be built in partnership with [VisionF Yachts](#). The Silent VisionF 82 will be a 25-metre catamaran equipped with solar panels and a battery pack that will provide the power for all household and comfort appliances onboard.





“I’m immensely proud of what [Silent-Yachts](#) has achieved over the years,” says [Silent-Yachts](#) founder and CEO Michael Köhler. “After beginning our research into solar yacht technologies in 2004, the company has evolved and expanded and last year’s sales show that we continue to grow.”

This newly founded partnership will bring the Silent-Group considerable manpower to start production of the Silent 60 series, Silent 80 series, Silent 100 series as well as the new Silent VisionF 82. The Silent-Group now also has access to more than 100,000 square metres of production space at the [Tuzla Viaport Marina](#), thanks to this relationship with the Turkish-based [VisionF Yachts](#).

Köhler continued, “We are now a truly international Group with diverse interests requiring more extensive resources and production space. This enables us to collaborate with other shipyards such as [VisionF](#) to assist them in harnessing solar technology as a step towards a more sustainable future.”

Even though the Silent-Group is yet to launch its first yacht, the first of which was due for delivery last year but is yet to be launched, it has announced that 2021 was “record-breaking” as it sold 21 yachts. Seventeen of these are currently in-build at different stages of production, among them eight Silent 60 series, six Silent 80 series, two Silent VisionF 82 and the first Silent 120.
