

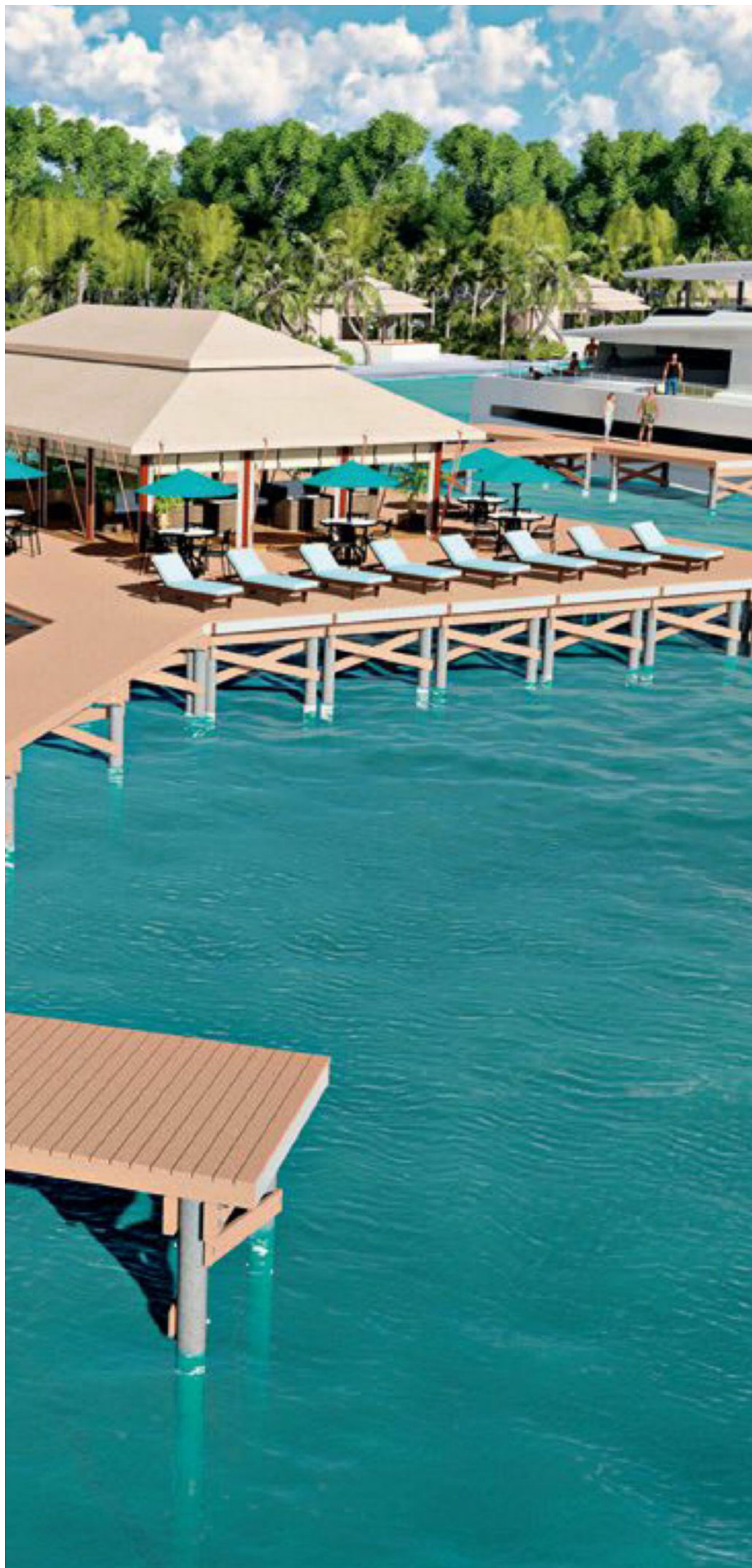




Solar-powered catamarans become floating villas at Silent-Yachts' concept resort.

Silent-Yachts is making waves in the marine industry. Known for developing the world's first solar-powered catamaran, the Austrian-based builder has recently unveiled a radically new floating resort concept, offering a sustainable alternative to the traditional waterfront resort. Developed by a separate division named Silent-Resorts, the floating resort features a host of amenities and facilities at the water's edge, including an arrivals dock and reception, restaurant, pool, clubhouse, gym and spa, as well as beachfront tented and hardwood timber suites. Most impressive, however, are the solar-powered floating 'villas' – 18m Silent 60 or 24m Silent 80 catamarans, where guests can stay onboard. While docked, the solar-powered yachts will be able to supply power to the rest of the resort's facilities on land. Each luxurious yacht has four suites with private bathrooms, a spacious saloon with a chef's kitchen, terrace and sundeck. Those in the mood for adventure need only unmoor their yachts and they'll be off in an instant, to wherever their wanderlust may take them.
