

All Silent Yachts up to 24m to feature Nuvolari Lenard design

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Catamaran builder Silent Yachts has engaged leading superyacht design firm Nuvolari Lenard to design a new generation of solar-powered catamarans.

The first model penned by Nuvolari Lenard is currently under development, with an anticipated launch in 2026. Beyond this debut, the Venice-based studio will design all new Silent Yachts models up to 24 metres. Nuvolari Lenard is known for its work on some of the world's most recognisable superyachts including the 106m *Black Pearl*, 122m *Kismet* and the muscular 141m *Nord*.

According to Silent Yachts, the partnership marks a significant development in its efforts to advance sustainable marine design while introducing elevated standards of accommodation and aesthetics.
