

## Silent Yachts to collaborate with Nuvolari Lenard for new yachts up to 24m

[Silent Yachts](#) has announced a close collaboration with [Nuvolari Lenard](#) to design a new generation of solar yachts for the [Silent Yachts](#) fleet up to 24 metres.



[Silent Yachts](#) currently produces several yachts ranging from 18 to 37 metres, including the SY60, SY80 and SY120 Explorer series. This new collaboration looks to bring together the two brands to create a new evolution of catamarans, with accommodation and styling from [Nuvolari Lenard](#).

“The collaboration is a blend of [Nuvolari Lenard](#)’s sophistication and innovative approach to yacht design with [Silent Yachts](#)’ philosophy of sustainability and advanced technology,” explained Silent Yachts CEO Fabrizio Iarrera.



The first model to feature interior and exterior design by [Nuvolari Lenard](#) is currently still in the design phase, but has an expected launch date of 2026. Moving forward, every vessel up to 24 metres will now be designed by the Venice-based studio.

Founded in 1990, [Nuvolari Lenard](#) is known for its work on some of the world’s most iconic yachts, such as the 141.63-metre [Lürssen](#) superyacht [Nord](#), the 106.7-metre [Oceanco](#) sailing yacht [Black Pearl](#) and more recently, the 122-metre [Lürssen](#) superyacht [Kismet](#).



“[Nuvolari Lenard](#) brings the same passion and attention to detail to both superyachts and smaller semi-custom yachts, always maintaining our signature style,” added co-founders Carlo Nuvolari and Dan Lenard.

According to [Superyacht IQ](#), [Silent Yachts](#) has several yachts in-build from its popular 23.95-metre Silent 80 series. The first two solar-electric Silent 80 catamarans were sold in June 2024, with an expected delivery date of 2025.
