## Flagship 24m Silent SY80 solar-electric catamaran yacht *Sundance* launched

The flagship 24.38-metre Silent SY80 solar-electric catamaran yacht *Sundance* has been launched from the Silent Yachts facility in Fano, Italy.

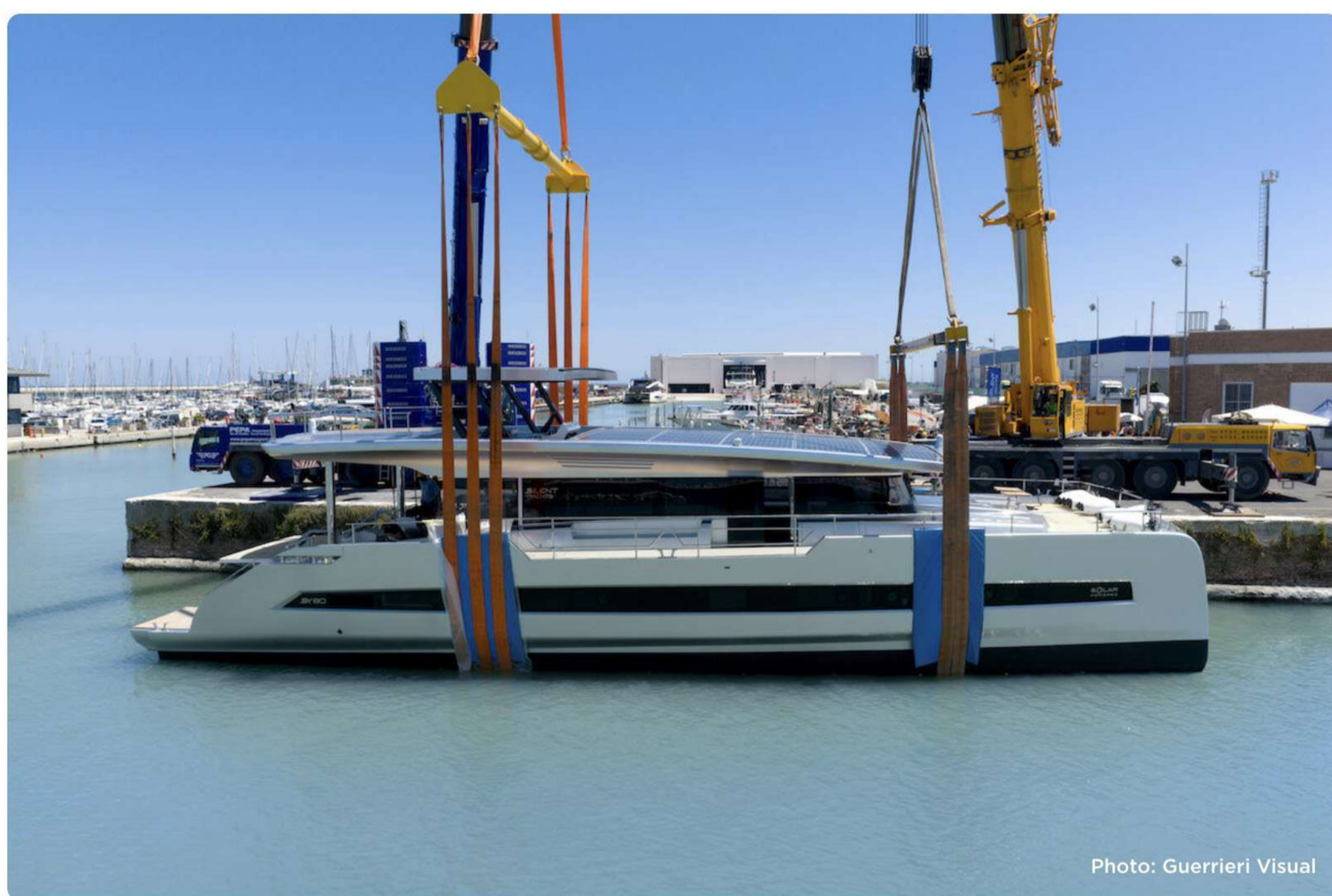

The Silent 80 yacht features interior and exterior design by Marco Casali Too Design, with naval architecture penned by MICAD and Isonaval.

Built entirely in Italy, the SY80 yacht is available in three configurations: 2-Deck, 3-Deck Open, and 3-Deck Closed. Each version is fully customisable, allowing owners to adapt every deck and layout element to suit their individual lifestyle and cruising needs.

The first SY80 yacht *Sundance* has been configured as a 2-Deck, with four guest staterooms including a master and VIP suites. This version offers ample space and is equipped with a dedicated helm station for steering the yacht while enjoying 360-degree views. The SY80 yacht includes a staircase aft of her port-side hull which can be raised to reveal a fully-enclosed garage. On the starboard side hull, additional storage areas can be used for toys and/or diving equipment.

Designed with long-range, environmentally-friendly cruising in mind, *Sundance* offers a silent, nearly zero-emission cruising experience, supported by a peak solar array of 22.4 kWp and a battery capacity of up to 696 kWh.

*Sundance* is capable of cruising comfortably at eight knots with a top speed of 12 knots. Silent Yachts has also sold two SY80 3-Deck versions.
